PUBLIC REQUESTS:

The following people emailed public requests to be read into the record:

Mr. James P. Dickson offered the following ideas for the Ocean Breeze property: walking and bike paths that could connect with the El Rio trail; a small 9-hole frisbee golf course; pickle/tennis courts and connecting Jeffery St. with Clint Moore Road.

Ms. Aggie Pappas suggested the following ideas for the Ocean Breeze property: preserving some of the natural habitats while introducing walking paths, playgrounds, exercise paths, bike paths, a small water park for children, pickleball courts, a community center for meetings and classes.

Ms. Peggy Haupt suggested using the West Delray Regional Park as a model for Ocean Breeze: bike trails, frisbee golf course, pavilions, open space, walking trails; a nature center with wetlands; a venue to rent for weddings/events; a restaurant or snack bar with outdoor seating; and would like the entrance on Yamato Road to be addressed.

Mr. Ryan Doyle would like a golf course at Ocean Breeze.

REGULAR BUSINESS:

1. Ocean Breeze Discussion

Ocean Breeze ILA

An Amended and Restated Interlocal Agreement for Ocean Breeze was presented for the Board's consideration and approval. The document incorporated the following requests from the Board of Commissioners: it allows for the development of recreation facilities which may include golf; it defines the parameters of the approval for the west side with a timeline and provides for access to the west side of the property for maintaining and developing the east side.

Executive Director Harms read an email into the record from Commissioner Rollins stating that he supports the passage of the revised ILA Agreement for Ocean Breeze between the District and the City of Boca Raton.

Mr. Horowitz, District Counsel, stated that he has reviewed the document and he supports it from a legal perspective.

Discussion ensued regarding the clarity of the language in the ILA pertaining to the approval process from the City. Once City Council approves the ILA amendment, the final approval will come after the permitting process has been cleared.

Mr. Horowitz noted that if City Council does not approve the Amended ILA or requests that it be further revised by staff, the new further revised version would come back to the District's Board for reconsideration.

Ocean Breeze Tunnel

FPL has turned the power back on at the tunnel which will allow the District to pump out the water that accumulates in the area.

Orange Pest Control

The District has contracted with Orange Pest Control to address some of the concerns at Boca Teeca.

Ocean Breeze RFI Results

The Ocean Breeze RFI responses are due back by April 9, 2021. District staff will share the results of the RFI with City Council to review.

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2. Verde K-8 Facility Use Agreement

This item was deferred. The proposed agreement has been sent to the School Board and will be added to a future agenda.

3. Swim & Racquet Center - Pool Deck Re-Surfacing Bids

Staff recommended awarding the bid for the Swim & Racquet Center Pool Deck Re-Surfacing RFP to Gold Coast Surfaces, Inc. for \$63,500. The RFP was advertised three times with only one bid returned. Once the Notice to Proceed is given to Gold Coast Services, Inc., the project is estimated to be completed in two weeks.

MOTION was made by Commissioner Wright and seconded by Commissioner Engel to award the bid for the Pool Deck Re-Surfacing project at the Swim & Racquet Center to Gold Coast Surfaces, Inc. in the amount of \$63,500.
